




TEST PROCEDURE

How to perform the test









EXTERNAL CONTROLS TEST:

- 1. Positive Control: Add exactly 5 drops of the Positive Control reagent to the Conjugate Tube marked for the Positive Control.
- 2. Sample Diluent/Negative Control: Add 200 μL (second mark) to the Conjugate Tube marked for the Negative Control.
- 3. Vortex or swirl the contents of the tubes for 10 seconds.
 4. Insert the narrow end of a Test Strip to each Conjugate Tube and firmly press down on the caps to close each tube. Incubate both tubes at 19-27 C for 20 minutes.
